- African Americans in California are 70% more likely than whites to suffer from asthma.
- More than 1 in 4 African American school children in urban Los Angeles suffer from asthma.

Who Profits:

- Big-Box retailers make a killing but won't take responsibility for clean air & good jobs at the ports.
